# Our Story

Founded in 1994, the Central Coast Youth Chorus has provided SLO County youth with the opportunity to experience the joy of singing in live choral performances while receiving a high-quality music education. During a time when many public schools have cut music education from their curriculum, CCYC fills in the gap and provides music education for young people in our local community.



Central Coast Youth Chorus offers weekly afterschool choral instruction under the care of highly qualified choral directors and concludes every season with concerts celebrating the music learned and rehearsed each semester. In addition to vocal instruction, we provide opportunities for youth singers to join performing groups like OperaSLO and Vocal Arts Ensemble in our local community to foster collaborations and to strengthen the vision for how music can become a life-long passion.

### Choir Levels

#### BRIO

Open to boys and girls in grades 1-3 who would like to explore and experience singing, music and fun!

#### **CADENCE**

Open to boys and girls in grades 4-6. No prior singing experience or audition is required.

#### **CADENZA**

Open to boys and girls, usually in grades 6-8. Voice check required.

#### **VIVACE**

An auditioned choir for young women in grades 8 and up.

#### **AVE (ADVANCED VOCAL ENSEMBLE)**

An auditioned chamber group made up of Vivace members who are usually ages 15+.\*

#### YME (YOUNG MEN'S ENSEMBLE)

Designed for both changed and unchanged voices. Young men in grades 6 and up are encouraged to join.
